ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter having come before this Board on appeal dated December 10, 2009 from a decision of the Baltimore County Employee's Retirement System's Board of Trustees dated November 10, 2009, denying the Appellant's application for disability retirement;

WHEREAS, the Board has been reviewing its docket with reference to inactive cases with the intent to dismiss and close as many of these cases as possible; and

WHEREAS, the subject matter has been held on the Board's docket since March 19, 2010, pending a medical re-evaluation of the Appellant; and


WHEREAS, the Board sent a request for status to Suzanne Berger, Assistant County Attorney, dated July 13, 2010, and received an emailed response dated July 13, 2010, indicating that Ms. Priester was granted an accidental disability; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated September 7, 2010, the Board of Appeals notified the Appellant that the above-entitled matter would be dismissed for lack of prosecution after a period of 30 days; and

WHEREAS, there has been no request made for hearing in this matter, nor objection made to said dismissal;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, this 4th day of November, 2010 by the Board of Appeals for Baltimore County that the above-referenced appeal in Case No.: CBA-10-018, be and is hereby **DISMISSED FOR LACK OF PROSECUTION**.
