## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

The 2007-2008 Current Expense Budget Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund The Erickson Foundation

FOR the purpose of amending the 2007-2008 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from private funds and made available to the County through The Erickson Foundation.

WHEREAS, The Erickson Foundation has made an award of private funds available to the Baltimore County Department of Aging to be used to do a pending study of men's knowledge regarding Osteoporosis; approximately 3,000 men, age 60 years and older residing in Baltimore County, Maryland registered in a Senior Center will receive a survey; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County

Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, the County Council may accept gifts and grants, appropriate same to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund and expend the same, said fund having been established solely for the purpose of accounting for certain monetary gifts and grants made available to the County for restricted purposes; and

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF

BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, be and is hereby amended by appropriating private funds made available to the Baltimore County Department of Aging, in the amount herein specified, to the following program:
