Dear Ms. Jennings,

Thank you for coming out to Kingsville recently to look into code violations at JSI Auto. When we spoke with Jeff Insley, the owner, I did not get the impression that he was too interested in complying with the code.

My original letter of complaint of July 9 included the photo below, taken 16 June, of an unlicensed, non-operable red Pontiac that had been there for a long time before that. As can be seen in the photo taken October 4, this Pontiac has not yet been moved.

Also, in this recent photo, there are several engine blocks set in front of the garage. Last month, I saw similar engine blocks there for ten days before they were finally moved. I understand from what you told Mr. Insley that this is a violation.

I was prompted to write again today after seeing the aftermath of one more crash caused by someone trying to turn left off of Belair Rd into JSI's parking lot. (In the following photo, the red car protruding into the roadway was the southbound car involved in the crash.) I'm sure that the large number of vehicles in this lot parked close to the roadway contributed to this crash. I believe that requiring the designation of a limited number of parking spaces sufficiently far away from the roadway would help this situation.

I trust that action can be taken to encourage Mr. Insley to remove all unlicensed, non-operable vehicles from this site and to stop storing vehicle parts in front of the business.
