Dears Sirs,

I request that you take action for the removal of flashing lights on a window sign just installed at the subject address. It is in violation of BCZR 450.6.B.3.

I realize that Code Enforcement is currently not issuing correction notices or citations for changeable copy signs while the issue of how often a message can change is addressed by new legislation, however, this is not a "changeable copy" sign as defined in the Table of Sign Regulations, since the message does not change. It is the lights surrounding the message which flash.

While there, could you also take steps to have the unlicensed van removed from its apparent permanent parking place close to Belair Rd, straddling the "sidewalk" (where the State spray-painted "ADA").

Thank you for your help in this matter. This is the first flashing sign which has appeared in Kingsville and, if not removed, will be followed quickly by many others.
